In 2010, Rebekah Abbott, a professional soprano now living in Hampshire, gathered together a small group of singers to learn and sing choral music for fun. From that small beginning, Holybourne Singers have grown into a choir of almost 70 people, passionate about performing accessible and much-loved music to reach as wide an audience as possible.

We have an annual timetable that schedules at least three concerts a year, some of which are shown below:-

During the past three years we have performed Handel's *Dixit Dominus*, Mozart's *Requiem*, Rossini's *Petite Messe Solennelle* and, at a "Come Along and Sing" event, Handel's *Messiah*.

The choir sang an *Out of Africa* concert in 2014 to a full audience of 300 and raised £895 for the Nelson Mandela Children's Fund. The Alton Herald review in August commented that the Singers "demonstrated their energy, refinement and astonishing versatility to a packed St Andrew's Church".

More recently we performed Mendelssohn's *Elijah* with a full orchestra, *A Summer Concert of Contemporary Music*, John Rutter's *Gloria* and the premiere of Chris Gardner's *Te Deum*. The programme for 2016 includes Bach's *Magnificat*, Vivaldi's *Magnificat* and Verdi's *Requiem*.



Holybourne Singers give 10% of our profit on ticket sales and a retiring collection at each performance to a chosen charity.

It costs on average £2000 to put on each of our concerts. For example, soloists charge up to £300 for rehearsal and performance while advertising, printing and banners cost around £600. We keep our ticket prices as low as possible whilst maintaining a balance between the extent of our "giving" and the need to retain funds for future performances. We are planning a tour for the choir in 2017.

Support of any kind is welcome and a commitment to financial assistance for, perhaps, 3 years would greatly help in the planning. The choir is managed by volunteers among the singers and more information is accessible at www.holybournesingers.co.uk
